



## **Club Excellence Awards for Rotary Year 2025/26**

There is an opportunity for Rotary Clubs to earn points to qualify for Club Excellence Awards during the Rotary year 2025/26, by participating in activities that promote good habits, strong values and ethics among school children.

The Criteria laid down is - Conduct a LMSV event with one or more schools to promote good habits with the participation of a minimum 10 LMSV performers per event. 3 points are awarded per event, up to a maximum of 4 events. Total number of points that can be earned is 12.

We encourage Rotary Clubs to engage with one or more schools within the community they serve or schools that they have connections with as parents, past pupils, teachers, coaches, sponsors etc. Through this engagement, Rotarians can introduce the LMSV concept, the songs, lyrics, animated videos and video clips of past performances that are all available on this website, for easy access at no cost. Using these resources, the school can motivate talented students to sing, dance, act, and speak on the theme of values and ethics. When they perform to an audience in a concert type arrangement or similar impactful event, the enabling Rotary Club will qualify for points.

Please keep a record of the date, time and venue of the event, participating schools, number of performers, and photos and videos of the performances.

What is described here is the basic criteria to earn the points on offer for Club Excellence Awards. Rotary Clubs are encouraged to go beyond this criteria, to promote ethics and values among young children, to lay the foundation for a decent, law abiding, disciplined and compassionate future generation.
